Composer Emily Levy and Writer-Director Mella Faye present an unflinching, heartfelt and uplifting exploration of love, loss and survival.

Music, dance and recorded interviews from conversations across the UK are richly layered by a world class ensemble of musicians, dancers and actors to create an extraordinary elegy to the power of story and human connection. Me Without You celebrates those we've lost and those of us who are still here.

As part of the making of this piece, we've been around the country, having conversations with people about their experiences of loss and how their lives have been shaped by the people they love who are no longer here. This active listening has been our creative driving force, recognising the value of sharing stories and being heard, and it is these stories that make the framework for our piece.

This ethos of listening also gives us a performance language to work with as our cast move fluidly between singing, instrumental playing and dance, whilst interacting with recorded speech and live and filmed visuals by Sal Pittman. The goal is always to

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creatively amplifying the voices and stories at the heart of the piece.

We all carry with us the people that we miss, and the impact on us of their lives and their death. This can be something that we talk about often or hold close as a very private part of us. Me Without You is a recognition of and testament to this part of all our lives and we have strived to create something this is hopeful as well as sad, playful as well as serious.

Accompanying the live performance is an online archive or scrapbook of stories and responses to our theme and the initial questions that we used in our conversations all over the country. This is an open resource and we warmly welcome anything you wish to contribute whether it's text, voice memos, videos, artwork, photos or anything else. These can feature names or be completely anonymous, it's entirely up to you.
